MAY IT PLEASE THE INDEPENDENT HEARINGS PANEL:

- The purpose of this memorandum, which is filed in addition to the reply for Christchurch City Council (Council) on Plan Change 14 (PC14), is to provide the Panel with a set of annotated provisions (attached as Appendix A) in accordance with the Panel's direction in paragraph [9] of Minute 36, dated 2 April 2024.
- 2. In accordance with the Panel's direction, the annotated provisions identify where revisions or changes are proposed that differ from the notified version of the provisions. The annotations identify, in coloured font, the origins of those changes in the evidence and/or submissions. For documents originating since the section 42A reports were prepared, cross-references to the relevant joint witness statements, section 32AA evaluations, and responses to Panel directions through the course of the hearings (etc) are identified, where applicable.
- 3. The annotated provisions are provided separately to the 'clean' (i.e. not annotated) provisions provided as Attachment 2 to the Council's reply. This is because, while every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the annotated provisions, the Council team has been focused on updating the provisions attached to the reply to accord with the Panel's requests in its Minute 48 of 14 May 2024.
- 4. To avoid the potential for any inaccuracy in the annotated provisions, the Council therefore requests that these are only used by the Panel for reference purposes, while using 'clean' provisions as the 'working version'.
