



**MAY IT PLEASE THE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. This memorandum is filed by counsel for Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities (“**Kāinga Ora**”) accompanying the evidence of Messrs Joll, Cleese, Colegrave, Brown and Ms Strachan (the “**Kāinga Ora witnesses**”) filed with the Independent Hearing Panel (“**IHP**”) hearing submissions on Plan Change 14 (“**PC14**”) to the Operative Christchurch District Plan (“**Plan**”).
2. Evidence on noise-related matters on behalf of Kāinga Ora is being filed by Mr Whittington separately.
3. The purpose of this memorandum is to:
  - (a) seek leave to file a consolidated set of tracked provisions showing the amendments sought by the Kāinga Ora witnesses in their evidence by 5pm Friday 22 September 2023; and
  - (b) to note that corporate evidence on behalf of Kāinga Ora on PC14 will also be filed (early) by 5pm on Friday 22 September 2023.
